- Performing opportunities: showcase concerts at the Edinburgh Fringe, Kings Place and the Southbank Centre, as well as slots supporting top professional groups, such as The Magnets, The Swingle Singers and The Real Group
- Advice, contacts, financial support, networks and resources for those looking to start or develop a group
- Recording sessions and opportunities to be featured on an a cappella compilation album
- Event management training and support for group managers and aspiring workshop leaders
- Nurturing the development of local networks, such as a cappella societies and mentoring programmes
